

# Summer Food Rocks! USDA Summer Meal Site Finder



The USDA has created a Summer Food Rocks! web tool to assist parents, teens and community members to find summer meal sites near them. At the moment, the web tool is populated with over 42,000 meal sites throughout the United States and children and teens up to 18 eat free. New sites will be added throughout the summer.

The web tool is available at [www.fns.usda.gov/summerfoodrocks](http://www.fns.usda.gov/summerfoodrocks) and can be used on smart phones or other personal electronic devices. Summer Food Rocks! features a search tool that enables users to find summer meal sites near the city, state, or zip code that they enter. Once a site has been identified, users can tap the screen to get the site address and more information about the dates and times that the site is open, as well as additional contact information.
