SUMMARY:

School-aged (kindergarten-5th grade) children residing on YPG attend James D. Price Elementary on post. Middle school (6th-8th grade) and high school (9th-12th grade) youth are bussed to schools off post approximately 22 miles from the installation. Families with children/youth that reside off post but that prefer that their child attend the YPG home schools may complete an open enrollment application. Families are encouraged to contact their school of choice as soon as possible to determine their child's eligibility and to submit the required paperwork. School districts may have additional requirements for out of district enrollment.

All school districts have an Exceptional Student Services program that provides services for students who have special needs. Some students may be transported off the installation to a school that better suits their needs.

SCHOOL REGISTRATION:

At what age can my child start school?

Children must be five years or older on or before August 31st of the current school year in order to be eligible to enroll in a public school.

What is required for enrollment?

1. Proof of Residency
2. Original Birth Certificate
3. Immunization Records
4. Withdrawal Slip (if applicable)
5. Report Card/Transcript (if applicable)
6. Picture ID of Parent Registering Student
7. Proof of Legal Guardianship (if child not living with one of the natural parents)

How do I enroll for school?

To register your child for school you will need to stop by the school's office and complete a registration packet. Yuma School District One gives you the option of downloading the registration forms from their website. Crane District also has an enrollment form that you may download and complete ahead of time.

SCHOOL CHOICE OPTIONS:

- **Public School Choice:** open enrollment is available in all the public schools with parents being responsible for transportation to and from school. Submitted application must meet deadline.
- **Private Schools:** there are several private schools ranging from pre-k to high school. For more information on available schools please contact your school liaison.
- **Home Schools:** parents who wish to home school their child must submit an Affidavit of Intent with the County School Superintendent within 30 days from the time the child begins to attend home school. - **Charter Schools:** open enrollment and no tuition. Some provide an online curriculum. For more information please visit <http://www.ade.az.gov/charterschools/search/SiteList.asp> or contact your school liaison.

REMINDERS:

Enroll your child in school on time. Public schools start at the beginning of August. If your child is starting with the school year remember to enroll your child prior to the school offices closing for the summer (usually second week in June) to ensure all documentation is received and your child is ready for school.

Visit your child's school district website. Prepare yourself to be an advocate for your child. Become familiar with the district's policies and procedures as well as the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunities for Military Children.
